10.2.1.2 Activity Report -

- a) There will be a PR Committee meeting on Saturday morning at 08:30 and that the members of the Labs are Vital project would join in at 10:30, any member of the CPD EC is welcomed.
- b) Labs are Vital Programs Eight meetings of Labs are Vital were held; 3 face to face and 5 by electronic media. There will be a booth at the present General Conference. Charles de Rohan, Abbott VP for Europe will give a short talk at the time of EJ presentation during the opening sessions. The CPD EC agrees that care should be taken so as to assure neutrality in the Labs are Vital program and there be no undue over exposition of Abbott. Also the content of the program should be provided by IFCC although recognizing that is a joined effort (IFCC/Abbott).
- c) Speakers Bureau List has been completed and sent to SD and EMD for review and comments. As there is evident overlap between the Speakers Bureau list and the VL Program list, the merger of the 2 was suggested and accepted in principle by the CPD EC. If National Societies turn to the IFCC list for a speaker and then extends an invitation, the Society would be solely responsible for the costs. If on the other hand, the speaker is proposed by IFCC then costs are shared.
- d) The PR brochure has been translated into Chinese, Portuguese, Spanish and Italian. GS mentioned that it has also been translated into Polish and has been used at a national meeting.
- e) In 2008 the PR brochure will be translated into Arabic, French and German. It was suggested that the National Representatives or Societies be first contacted first to see whether such versions are needed. Indian and Japanese translations are also envisaged, with the same proviso.
- f) A new brochure for lay public is being contemplated. The idea will be discussed at the forthcoming PR/Labs are Vital meeting to be brought back to CPD EC. It was suggested that EB be asked whether they would be interested.
